The CFB Security Team wants you to be aware that scams are on the rise! Please be careful. Ask yourself, “How do I know if this is a scam?”

- * Is this person suddenly interested in my finances or sending or receiving money?
- * Have I ever met this person, or do I only interact with them via email/text/messenger?
- * Are they asking me to buy gift cards? (No legitimate company will take gift card payments.)
- * Are they telling me not to tell anyone or not to tell my banker what I’m doing?
- * Is this person requesting access to my computer or my bank information?
- * Do I even use the service/product this person is saying I do?
- * Did they ask for unusual information such as online bank information?



Be skeptical, ask questions, research independently, and ask and TRUST your banker! Two most common SCAMS in 2022:

1) Romance Scam – What is it? Fraud targeting emotionally vulnerable victims with companionship, with the goal of manipulating them into sending funds, account information, or making transactions on the criminal’s behalf. How does it work? Fraudsters make contact through social media or dating sites and will portray themselves as someone overseas or someone who travels (military, oil worker, etc). They will ask for money for travel expenses to come and see you, or for business opportunities, and may request access to your accounts.

2) Computer Take Over – What is it? Someone posing as a company (usually Amazon, Microsoft, Norton Antivirus, etc) will state you owe them money and attempt to gain access to your computer. How does it work? They will manipulate your bank account and make it look as if they’ve given you a refund and overpaid you, and request the difference back. Fraudsters will push to have money wired to an account to ‘pay back’ the money they are owed or insist you send them gift cards.
