<u>Clinton Presidential Library</u> - The William J. Clinton Presidential Library and Museum is the presidential library of Bill Clinton, the <u>the 42nd President of the United States</u> (1993–2001). It is located in Little Rock, Arkansas and includes the Clinton Presidential Library

Little Rock Central High School National Park - In 1957, Little Rock Central High School was the epicenter of confrontation and a catalyst for change as the fundamental test for the United States to enforce African American civil rights following Brown v. Board of Education. Learn how the sacrifice and struggle endured by the Little Rock Nine have provided opportunities and opened doors for those seeking equality and education around the world.

<u>Marlsgate Plantation</u> - The Dortch Plantation, also known as the William P. Dortch House or the Marlsgate Plantation, is an historic house near Scott, Arkansas. Dortch House is the only plantation home in Arkansas that is fully furnished in the antebellum period style and available for tours and private events

<u>Hot Springs Bath Houses</u> – Trolley Tour - Hot Springs National Park is a 5,500-acre area in downtown Hot Springs, AR with the famous bath houses from the early 1900's. The park also provides opportunities for public health and wellness activities, and preserves and protects many historic structures, cultural landscapes, and natural settings. Hot Springs Famous Trolley Tour will provide history and background to this interesting city!

<u>Crystal Bridges</u> - Founded by philanthropist and arts patron Alice Walton, Crystal Bridges is a public non-profit art museum. It opened on November 11, 2011. Celebrate the American Spirit and Unite the Power of Art with the Beauty of Nature. A World-Class Collection of American Art Nestled in 120-Acres of Ozark Woods.

<u>Original Walmart Location & 5 and 10 cent store</u> - Classic candy, period music and more; relive dime store era of original Walton's 5&10. Exhibit gallery features interactives. Includes such memorabilia as Sam Walton's Medal of Freedom and original office. All artifacts authentic including Mr. Sam's iconic 1979 Ford F150 pickup truck. Spark Café Soda Fountain offers ice cream treats in a fifties setting.

<u>Bass Pro Shop/Angler Lodge/Hemingway's</u> - As an avid young angler, Johnny Morris founded Bass Pro Shops in 1972 on 8 square feet of space in the back of his father's liquor store in **Springfield, Missouri**. This is the first location of the iconic store. Hemingway's is a theme restaurant located within the store. Angler Lodge is a rustic hotel built across the street. Travelers will love the wood like décor.

<u>Johnny Morris' Wonders of Wildlife National Aquarium</u> - consists of a 1.5-million-gallon Aquarium Adventure showcasing 35,000 live fish, mammals, reptiles, amphibians, and birds, and immersive Wildlife Galleries that bring visitors eye-to-eye with the greatest collection of record-setting game animals ever assembled. Created by noted conservationist and Bass Pro Shops founder/CEO Johnny Morris, the 350,000square-foot experience celebrates those who hunt, fish, and act as stewards of the land and water.

<u>Lambert's – Home of the "Throwed Rolls"</u> - LAMBERT'S is, of course, known for their Throwed Rolls, and everyone enjoys catching a roll or two. Last year they averaged baking 520 dozen rolls per day, for a grand total of 2,246,400 individual rolls.
