Recently we have seen an increase in scammers claiming to be from Geek Squad, Amazon, and various other companies. Emails and text messages are received in regards to services rendered or purchases that recipients didn't make. The messages are an attempt to gather credit card information.

If you receive a message like this:

• Stop and think - Did I buy this product or service? Does this make sense?

• Check your Amazon account (log in from a new browser, <u>not</u> from any link in the text/email) to see if the purchase was actually made

- · Check your bank accounts or call in to check and see if there is any unusual activity
- · Call the bank with questions or for assistance

Do not:

- · Click links or call any of the phone numbers in suspicious emails or texts
- Never give out debit card or other personal information
