

As we enter into the holiday season, there are a couple of things our Fraud Prevention Team want to remind you of:

If you plan to go away for the winter, please give the bank your new address. The post office WILL NOT forward mail from the bank, which includes your statements and important documents.

BEWARE OF PHONE AND EMAIL SCAMS REGARDING PURCHASES. If you receive a message regarding an online purchase:

- Stop and think "Did I buy this product or service? Does this make sense?"
- Check your Amazon account. (Log in from a new browser, not from a link in the text/email.) Was there a purchase made?
- Check your bank accounts or call in to check and see if there is any unusual activity.
- If a family member or friend calls you asking for money or help, check the number and then call them back on a trusted **known** number.

Do not EVER do any of these three things:

- 1) Click links or call any of the phone numbers in suspicious emails or texts.
- 2) Give out debit card or other personal information.
- 3) Give money to, or receive money from, anyone you do not personally know.
