Day 3: Vancouver Sights - VIA Rail's Canadian

After breakfast, return to Vancouver by ferry and enjoy a sightseeing tour to include 1,000 acres Stanley Park, Gastown and China town. Day 6: Jasper - Icefields Parkway - Athabasca Glacier - Banff - Lake Louise

We'll depart Jasper and journey along the breathtaking Columbia Icefields Parkway. We'll board the Columbia Icefield snow coach for a thrilling tour on the Athabasca Glacier, experiencing the icefield's stunning beauty up close. We'll then continue to Banff, Alberta, where we'll spend the next two nights. Lake Louise may be the most beautiful place you'll ever visit. Get ready for an unbelievable dining experience at Chateau Lake Louise overlooking the magnificent alpine lake. **B**, **D**

Day 7: Banff & Yoho National Parks

This morning, motor through the picturesque Bow River Valley past the castle-like Banff Springs Hotel. Ascend high into the heart of Yoho National Park to inspirational Moraine Lake and the Valley of the Ten Peaks. Cross the Continental Divide and see lovely Emerald Lake and nearby Natural Bridge before arriving at Takakkaw Falls. Day 8: Banff - Calgary - Indianapolis - Kokomo
