Day 1 - October 10:
KOKOMO, IN - DUBLIN, IRELAND

This afternoon, we depart Kokomo for the Indianapolis Airport and our trans-Atlantic nonstop flight to Dublin, Ireland. This overnight flight aboard a wide-bodied jet is bound for the Emerald Isle. Wake up to your first glimpse of Ireland’s forty shades of green as we glide over Dublin Bay.

Day 2 - October 11:
DUBLIN

We will arrive this morning in Dublin. After collecting our bags and proceeding through customs, we will meet our driver who will transfer us to the hotel. We check into the Trinity City Hotel for a 2-night stay. This afternoon is at your leisure. This evening, we join as a group for a “welcome to the tour” 3-course Irish dinner, including entertainment. **D**

Day 3 - October 12:
DUBLIN CITY TOUR

Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning. We will then meet our guide and take a comprehensive city tour and see all the major attractions including Trinity College and the Book of Kells, National Library, and St. Patrick’s Cathedral. Pass by the famous colorful front doors of Merrion Square and Fitzwilliam Square, two of Dublin’s Georgian squares which serve as the cultural and architectural hearts of the city. The rest of the afternoon and evening are free for you to explore the city on your own. **B**

Day 4 - October 13:
KILKENNY - WATERFORD

After an included breakfast at the hotel, we depart Dublin and head south towards Waterford. We will make a stop along the way in Kilkenny where you will have free time to explore and have lunch on your own. You may choose to see some beautiful historic buildings or visit one of the many breweries! Later we continue on to Waterford. Choose between an included tour of the House of Waterford crystal or the Medieval Museum. We will check into our hotel in Waterford this evening for a one-night stay and an included dinner at the hotel. **B, D**

Day 5 - October 14:
BLARNEY - KILLARNEY

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel this morning. We then continue on our journey southwest towards Killarney. We will make a stop along the way in Blarney where admission is included to Blarney Castle and Blarney Woollen Mills. You will even have a chance to kiss the famous Blarney Stone! We then continue on to Killarney where we will spend the next two nights. Before an included dinner at the hotel, we will take a short sightseeing cruise on Loch Leane. Hear tales of the history of the buildings and castles around the lake while taking in the beautiful rolling hills and scenery. **B, D**

Day 6 - October 15
RING OF KERRY PANORAMIC TOUR

Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning. We then depart for another exciting day of sightseeing. Our driver-guide will take us on a panoramic tour of the Ring of Kerry. This is one of Ireland’s most popular drives. As we drive along the coastline of the Iveragh Peninsula, you will see stunning wind-swept cliffs, still lakes, lost valleys, and rocky mountains. Dinner and the rest of the evening are on your own. **B**

Day 7 - October 16:
CLIFFS OF MOHER - LIMERICK

After breakfast at the hotel, we start heading north towards Limerick. Along the way we will take a short ferry from Tarbert to Killimer to cross the Shannon River. We will then stop at one of the most stunning sights in Ireland, the Cliffs of Moher, where admission to the Visitor Center is



included. Believed to be home to otherworldly beings and mystical creatures, the stunning Cliffs of Moher will leave you captivated with a sense of wonder and mystery. Then we will pass through the Burren on the way to Ennis. The Burren has over 70% of Ireland’s native flowers and is the only place in the world where Arctic plants and Alpine plants grow beside Mediterranean plants. Later we check into our hotel in Limerick for a one-night stay. Dinner is on your own this evening. **B**

Day 8 - October 17:
GALWAY - SLIGO

Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning. We then continue our journey north towards Galway and Sligo. Admission is included to Rathbaun Farm, a traditional Irish working farm, where we will enjoy tea, coffee, and scones. We will then continue on while taking in the stunning sights of Galway Bay, and make a quick stop in Galway for a tour. We finally make our way to Sligo where we will spend one night. Dinner will be included at a local favorite this evening. **B, D**

Day 9 - October 18:
DONEGAL - DERRY

After breakfast at the hotel, we continue on north towards Derry. We will make a stop in Donegal en route and have lunch on your own and some free time to explore. Later we arrive in Derry for a walking tour. Officially called Londonderry, this compact walkable city is filled with history and is home to Ireland’s only completely intact historical city wall. Later we will check into our hotel for a two-night stay and an included dinner. **B, D**

Day 10 - October 19:
INISHOWEN PENINSULA

Breakfast is included at the hotel today. We will then depart for a tour of the Inishowen Peninsula including Malin Head, Ireland’s most northerly point. This is a favorite spot for tourists and locals alike with its spectacular views of the Inishowen Peninsula and beyond to the broad sweep of the Atlantic Ocean. Dinner will be on your own before returning to Derry for the rest of the evening at your leisure. **B**

Day 11 - October 20:
GIANT’S CAUSEWAY - BELFAST

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before departing for Belfast. Along the way you will get to experience the awe inspiring sights of Giant’s Causeway. These basalt columns are a natural wonder and are sure to impress! Later we will arrive in Belfast at our last hotel for a two-night stay. Dinner will be included at a local favorite. **B, D**

Day 12 - October 21:
BELFAST

Breakfast is included at the hotel this morning. We will then depart for our final day of sightseeing. Meet your guide and board the coach for a half day city tour of Belfast. Along the way, you will see all the major sights including City Hall, the Grand Opera House, St. George’s Market, and St. Anne’s Cathedral. Admission to the Titanic Belfast experience is also included. The rest of the day will be yours to enjoy at your leisure. A “farewell to the tour” dinner is included this evening. **B, D**

Day 13 - October 22:
DUBLIN - KOKOMO, IN

After breakfast, we board our motor coach and bid farewell to Northern Ireland as we make our way to the Dublin Airport. Upon arrival, there is ample time to browse the duty-free store before you board your return flight. We leave behind “the land of a thousand welcomes” sparkling in a setting of silver coastline and a patchwork of emeralds. **B**
