Dr. Mark Canada, Indiana University Chancellor, and English Professor Dr. Christopher Young, Professor of History at Indiana University Northwest A tour of Upton Sinclair's Back of the Yards, Chicago Upton Sinclair said of *The Jungle*, his expose of Chicago's stockyards, "I aimed at the public's heart and by accident I hit it in the stomach." Sinclair sought to show the exploitation of immigrants like his protagonist, Jurgis Rudkus, but it was his descriptions of the meat-packing industry that caused a bigger stir. In this tour, we will explore the locales relevant to Sinclair's investigation during the turn of the century. One of our tour hosts, Dr. Christopher Young, will give personal narrative, as his grandparents spent their entire lives in Back of the Yards. We will also enjoy time at the Chicago Cultural Center, as well as time for shopping and lunch at Navy Pier.
