DAY 1:

Kokomo - Indianapolis - Kalispell, Montana - West Glacier, Montana

Your adventure begins by transferring to the Indianapolis Airport and flying to Kalispell, Montana. Once in Kalispell, board a private coach and travel to **West Glacier** for a 2-night stay. Join your fellow travelers for a "Welcome Dinner" at a local restaurant before retiring for the night. **D**

DAY 2:

Glacier National Park - Going to the Sun Highway

See **Glacier National Park** via the world famous "Going to the Sun Highway," amid magnificent snowcapped peaks, gleaming lakes, and the virgin forests of the McDonald Valley aboard the historic Jammer coaches. **B**

DAY 3:

West Glacier, MT - Butte, MT

This morning, we depart West Glacier and make our way through the **Flathead National Forest** area and to **Deer Lodge** and the **Grant-Kohrs Ranch National Historic Site** commemorating the Western cattle industry from the 1850's to a working 1,600-acre ranch managed by the National Park Service. We overnight in Butte, Montana. **B**

DAY 4:

Butte, MT - West Yellowstone, MT

After breakfast we will travel through **Beaverhead National Forest** for spectacular scenery. See the Madison Canyon Earthquake area and enjoy Alder Gulch, home of the ghost town **Virginia City**. We continue into West Yellowstone for a 2-night stay just outside the park entrance. **B**

DAY 5:

Yellowstone National Park

After breakfast this morning, we begin our exploration of **Yellowstone** by traveling to the incredibly beautiful Upper & Lower Loops. Yellowstone is beyond special; it is the world's first national park. It is over 2.2 million acres packed inside an ancient caldera. Geysers, waterfalls, wildlife and scenic beauty. Stop for a fascinating walking tour of the terraces at **Mammoth Hot Springs**, then view both the upper and lower falls at the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone. After a full day of scenic beauty, we return to our hotel for the night. **B**

DAY 6:

Yellowstone - Grand Teton National Park

This morning, we continue exploring many of Yellowstone's natural attractions in the southern part of the park including time for wildlife viewing and panoramic photos. We depart Yellowstone and travel through more amazing areas - the **Grand Tetons** and **Jackson Hole**. Just as you thought you could not see anything more spectacular, the Tetons are sure to mesmerize your spirit. Its soaring mountain peaks and glacial-fed lakes parallel the Swiss Alps. Later, we arrive at the mountain community of Jackson Hole for a two-night stay. **B**

DAY 7:

Float trip on the Snake River

Today we will explore the Tetons as we embark on a magnificent float trip with lunch included on the **Snake River**. This afternoon has been set aside for you to enjoy the Jackson Hole area at your leisure. Your hotel is 2 blocks from the Jackson Hole square. This evening experience Jackson Holes' original

Chuck Wagon Dinner.

Traveling by horse drawn covered wagons you are swept away from the town of Jackson into beautiful **Cache Creek Canyon**. With your own wrangler to guide you, they will drive your team of horses up the trail. As you pull into camp you can smell the sweet aroma of a Dutch oven dinner, to welcome your arrival. Enjoy this savory home-cooked meal as you go through the chow line. Then you can return all you want until we reach the bottom of the pots. Afterwards, the Bar T 5 Band takes the stage to entertain you with laughter and great hand-clapping music. Have your camera ready because one of your fellow travelers may even end up on stage before the end of the night. **L, D**
