



Refund Policy

Day 1:

Kokomo, IN - Indianapolis - Rapid City, South Dakota - Keystone, South Dakota

Day 2:

Crazy Horse Memorial - Mt. Rushmore

We continue to another amazing landmark, Mount Rushmore, and learn about the history and construction of this famous monument. Day 3:


Badlands National Park - Wall Drug Store - Custer State Park
Following breakfast, travel into and through Badlands National Park, consisting of 244,000 acres of sharply eroded buttes, pinnacle and spires blended with the largest protected mixes of grass prairies in the USA.

Then, explore further into Wall, South Dakota. The town of Wall, located eight miles north of the Badlands, may look like nothing special, yet thanks to Wall Drug, which opened its doors in 1931 as a pharmacy and vet supply shop, it's known around the world. While visiting this national treasure, enjoy lunch on your own and be sure to get your free



ice water, 5 cent coffee and a free bumper sticker. Next, it's on to Custer State Park, which is comprised of 71,000 acres of spectacular terrain and abundant wildlife. Herds of buffalo are a common sight here in the park.

Later this evening, enjoy an included dinner followed by an unforgettable view of Mount Rushmore at night. Experience the most spectacular program, the evening lighting ceremony held in the amphitheater, a must see when you are touring the beautiful Black Hills of South Dakota. Day 4:

Devil's Tower National Monument - Deadwood, South Dakota
Today, we will head west to visit Devil's Tower National Monument. Afterwards, head to Deadwood, a national historic landmark where the famous and infamous have left their marks. Follow the footsteps of Old West legends like Wild Bill Hickok and Calamity Jane as you explore the beauty and history of this one-of-a-kind outlaw town.
